### **Conversations around Justice I**

### **Conversations around Justice II**

Recent months have witnessed a growing consciousness of overaggressive policing that has resulted in the murder of unarmed African Americans. While this is not new, people are becoming more aware of these tragedies because of social media. Too often, allegations and accusations outpace conversations. This session creates space for law enforcement officers and pastoral leaders to talk about realities and strategies for resolving tensions between law enforcement officers and African-American communities.
