We here at Mission of Grace are so very grateful for the support of Lott Carey and we are honored to be part of the 126th Lott Carey Annual Conference.

Mission of Grace has been partnered with Lott Carey since 2015. Mission of Grace has been serving a small village located 1 hour north of Port Au Prince called Carriès for the past 13 years. The vision and hope of our founder, Ms Linotte Joseph, is that Carriès would become City of Grace, known as a city on a hill whose light cannot be put out. One of the things that makes our mission somewhat unique, is that we are embedded in the community. The goal is not to simply improve the quality of life, but to train and equip the future leaders of Haiti. We achieve this goal through Children of Grace Orphanage, Home of Grace Elderly Home, Grace Community Medical Clinic, Grace Community Christian School, Grace Community Soup Kitchen and Grace Community Christian Church. These ministries are in the midst of the people we are ministering to and our daily lives are woven together.

Mission of Grace serves over 900 people per day. We have 150 children at Children of Grace Orphanage, 30 residents at Home of Grace Elderly Home, we serve over 50 patients each day at Grace Community Medical Clinic, we have 550 students enrolled at Grace Community Christian School, we serve one hot meals to 200 people 6 days a week in our community through Grace Community Soup Kitchen and we have over 150 each week coming to hear the Word of God at Grace Community Christian Church.

To serve this amount of people each day the needs we require to thrive are finances to feed over 500 people each day and to meet our monthly payroll for over 80 full time employees, we also need medical supplies for or medical clinic along with donations of hygiene products, clothes, shoes, and blankets to meet the needs of our community and ministries. School supplies are also needed each fall to help us prepare for our school year along with finances for books that we have to purchase.

We ask that you pray for breakthrough for Haiti. That in the next few months there will be help that will come and rescue the people from the gang violence, hunger, malnutrition, suffering and so much more. We also ask that you pray for the heart of the Haitian people so that they many turn from their weakened way and turn their hearts back to our Father. We can do a lot and bring intervention to Haiti but that will only fix their physical needs for a time. Only if their hearts turn to righteousness then God will heal the land and restore Haiti.

We ask that you lift Mission of Grace up with continual prayer for the Leadership team as the present challenges of road blockages, food price increase and funding often times feels overwhelming. Please also pray for more donors and donations to continue to come so that we can continue the ministry that God gave us.

We are so grateful to be partnered with Lott Carey over all these years. Your prayers and support mean so much to us. We are so grateful for the soup boxes that are sent to us each year. We look forward to serving alongside you for many more years to come.
