Lott Carey W.I.S.E. 2024 SALT Awards' Guidelines February 2024

Dear SALT Award Nominator,

Lott Carey Women of Service Everywhere (WISE) is currently accepting nominations for the Lott Carey 2024 W.I.S.E. SALT Awards. Awards are given to recognize women who (1) demonstrate faithful commitment to mentoring, inspiring, and developing others; (2) support the call for advocacy, recognizing the human rights of all and promoting social justice; (3) advance the mission thrust of Lott Carey by touching lives with transforming love through ministries of compassion, evangelism, empowerment, and advocacy; and (4) maintain an active role in the vision of their local church, region, state and/or global communities.

W.I.S.E. will honor a maximum of twelve (12) Women – three (3) women in each of the four (4) categories. Final candidates will be recognized during the 127th Lott Carey Annual Session, at the Renasant Convention Center, Memphis, Tennessee. The specific date/time is to be decided.

The **GUIDELINES** for the awards listed below provide a framework to name women who meet the following criteria:

- The **Ruth Award** recognizes the leadership and service of women engaged in ministries of compassion.
- The **Dorcas Award** recognizes the leadership and service of women engaged in ministries of evangelism.
- The **Jael Award** recognizes the leadership and service of women engaged in ministries of empowerment.
- The **Esther Award** recognizes the leadership and service of women engaged in ministries of advocacy.

Ministry initiatives should be intentional about generating sacrificial gifts supporting Lott Carey's mission.

Nominations **MUST** be sent in writing and received on or before **Friday, May 22, 2024**.

Nomination submissions must include the following:

- **Information from the Nominator** (email address and telephone number) AND your award suggestion. For example, Ruth, Dorcas, Jael, or Esther.
- **Full name and information** about the Nominee including:
 - The **Nominee's local church with a paragraph** describing the rationale for the nomination, along with multiple examples of nominees' service involvement, defining if service was with Lott Carey, their local church, region, state, or global community.
- A **bio** for the nominee. This is in addition to the written rationale for the nomination.
- An **individual photo of the nominee** suitable for publication, their **telephone number**, and **email address**.

ALL nominations must be sent in writing as a complete package. The package may be forwarded via email to, justvette.pearson@aol.com, OR via U.S. mail to, Lott Carey W.I.S.E. SALT Awards, c/o Sis. If more than twelve (12) eligible nominations are received, the Nominating Committee, in consultation with WISE leadership, will review the content of the written nominations, then select the top twelve (12) nominees. In case of a tie, the postmark date and/or email receipt date may be used for this purpose. The results will be communicated to nominators and nominees' churches no later than **Wednesday, July 17, 2024**.

Thank you for considering this request and for your prompt submission of nominations **on or before May 22, 2024**. We hope you will join us at the 127th Lott Carey Annual Session in Memphis, Tennessee, August 12-15, 2024.
