# Dear Lott Carey Family,

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

I begin this report with a heart full of gratitude. Thank you for the profound honor

and sacred trust you have bestowed upon me to serve as the Executive Secretary-Treasurer/CEO of this historic and mission-driven Convention. I am humbled and inspired daily by the dedication, resilience, and sacrificial spirit that define our Lott Carey network. We are a people on mission; resolute, compassionate, and committed to transforming lives through the love of Christ.

This annual report offers a window into the work we have collectively accomplished over the past year. It also presents our ongoing challenges, the evolving landscape of global mission, and a vision of sustainable hope for the future.

# Trends in Global Mission: Challenges and Opportunities

The global mission field is experiencing dynamic shifts. Increased migration, political instability, climate change, and rising secularism continue to shape the context of ministry worldwide.

The global South remains a vibrant center of Christianity's growth, while the need for discipleship, justice, and infrastructure remains critical. The decision by the United States government to suspend

the operations of USAID has had a ripple effect. In many regions, particularly on the African Continent, USAID supported health and development programs were lifelines.

Lott Carey is now witnessing firsthand the strain on local healthcare systems, educational institutions, and food security efforts. Yet, this challenge has also presented an opportunity for the Church and other non-profit religious groups, especially our mission partnerships, to step into the gap with holistic ministry and sustainable interventions.

## New Initiatives: Lott Carey Responds with Vision



**David Emmanuel and Pamela Goatley School** – Bamba Town, Gbarpolu County, Liberia.

This fourteen classroom K-12 school is under construction, thanks to the partnership with Compassion International and your generous giving. When completed, it will provide educational opportunities for over five hundred students annually.

Vocational Training Facility – Frankadua, Ghana



Through the generous donation of the Alfred Street Baptist Church, a \$243,212.77 construction began this year on a vocational training facility aimed at equipping young women with skills in Tailoring, Cosmetology, Hospitality and Catering Management, and Information Technology.

The building will consist of six classrooms for training, a library, and an Information Communication Center. This center will help reduce youth unemployment

and provide Christian mentorship, especially to young girls emancipated from the indenture servitude of the Trokosi System.

### Women's Empowerment Center - Kipsitet, Kenya



The rehabilitation and completion of our longstanding center in Kipsitet, Kenya is now underway. When completed, this center will serve as a safe space for marginalized women to receive vocational training, engage in empowerment programs and seek opportunities to engage in small businesses to support their families.

The Board of Directors agreed to name the facility the Rosetta Tabb Graham Women's Empowerment Center. Sister Graham, now deceased, was a member of Alfred Street Baptist Church and served as President of Lott Carey's Women in Service Everywhere (WISE), 2018-2020. She will be remembered as a woman whose life exemplified service, empowerment, and love for missions. The completion of this project is funded by the Alfred Street Baptist Church of Alexandria, Virginia.

During the reporting period, our investments in global mission were significant:

- Education. Over 15,000 students in twenty-nine schools received educational support and training in various disciplines including K-12, theological and practical skills, and computer training.
- **Health Care.** We helped fund nine health care facilities and medical outreaches in Kenya, Liberia, Guyana, and India, providing care to thousands of individuals.
- Women & Youth Empowerment. Our women's and youth-focused programs have grown across three continents, offering micro-loans, business training, and leadership development.

- Advocacy. We continued advocacy against the Trokosi system and for the reintegration of liberated young women in Ghana.
- Capacity Building. Hundreds of pastors and church leaders received training through our Thriving Congregation initiative, global theological partnerships, and pastors' enrichment program.
- Food Security. Through our Kids Against Hunger program, we packed and shipped 350,000 high-protein rice meals to Liberia, Haiti, and various food banks across the United States.
- Safe Feet Program. 500 school children in underserved communities in Liberia received shoes as part of Lott Carey Safe Feet initiative. Thanks to the generous donations from St. Matthew Baptist Church, Open Door Baptist Church, and Trinidad Baptist Church.
- Wells for Wellness. Building wells in Sierra Leone and Liberia provided vital access to clean water, improving public health and reducing the spread of waterborne diseases. These wells empower communities by saving time and labor, especially for women and children who often bear the burden of water collection. Investing in clean water infrastructure fosters long-term development, support education, and strengthens local economies.
- Disaster Relief. We have extended vital support to disaster-impacted communities in North Carolina, California, and St. Louis, providing emergency and recovery relief resources.

  Through partnerships with local organizations and churches, we delivered food, supplies, and financial assistance to those most affected. This compassionate outreach reflects Lott Carey's ongoing commitment to local missions and community restoration in times of crisis.

### **Annual Ministry Programs to People Impact**

- 350,000 people benefited from feeding program
- 23,000 people served through healthcare facilities
- 15,000 students
- 4,000 people served through disaster relief services
- 300 church communities
- 29 schools
- 9 vocational training centers

In total, **392,000 people** have been served through Lott Carey ministries.

**Growth and Reach: Churches and Donors** 

- Over the past five years, we have added 213 NEW churches and 1,247 new donors.
- As of this report, our donor database includes 762 churches and institutions and 2,247 individual donors.

### **Fund Development: Challenge and Call**

Religious non-profits across the board face increased competition for donor dollars and changing giving patterns. Still, mission requires funding. The spiritual and humanitarian work we do together cannot continue without your fervent prayers and faithful generosity. Your giving directly saves lives, educates children, and lifts communities out of poverty. I encourage churches to budget intentionally for global mission and for individuals to make regular contributions. Every gift matters.

### Vision for Sustainability: Investing in the Future

As we look forward, sustainability is not just a goal, it is a necessity. To that end, we are inviting support for the following major initiatives:

- **Liberia.** Rehabilitating 1,500 acres of farmland to enhance food security and economic stability.
- Guyana. Developing 500 acres of land for agricultural purposes and community development.
- **Kenya.** Expanding our coffee farming enterprise to generate ongoing revenue for mission work.

Name of mission: African AIDS Initiative International (AAII)

Year partnership with Lott Carey began: 2006

Name of Superintendent/Leader: Elleni Gebreamlak

### **Nature of the Mission:**

The African AIDS Initiative International (AAII) is a Christ-centered organization committed to combating HIV/AIDS and promoting reproductive health in Ethiopia. Since its inception, AAII has focused on providing accessible, high-quality Voluntary Counseling and Testing (VCT) services through its Mobile VCT Center. These services include emergency contraception, pregnancy testing, and reproductive health counseling.

AAII also emphasizes youth-friendly services, particularly for young women, to ensure that interventions are responsive to the actual needs of the community.

### **Impact of Ministry:**

Highlights from 2024–2025 include:

- 8,900 individuals received HIV counseling and testing services through the Mobile VCT Center (46% female, 54% male).
- Clients who tested positive were referred to appropriate care and support services.
- 48,500 male condoms were distributed via the mobile center.
- 5,000 brochures on HIV/AIDS prevention and care were produced and distributed.
- 175 undergraduate female students at Addis Ababa University received emergency contraception.
- 50 students received oral contraceptives.
- 200 students received pregnancy testing and one-on-one reproductive health counseling.

### **Number of Persons/Communities Served:**

Over 8,900 individuals received HIV counseling and testing services. Additionally, hundreds of university students benefited from reproductive health services.

### **Needs for Ministry to Thrive:**

- Continued financial support for the Mobile VCT Center operations.
- Increased access to reproductive health supplies and educational materials.
- Technical support for expanding youth-friendly services.
- Resources to scale outreach to additional university communities.

### **Prayer Requests:**

- For the health and safety of all clients and staff.
- For continued provision and sustainability of AAII programs.
- For wisdom and strength for leadership and volunteers.
- For the expansion of services to reach more vulnerable populations.

### **Impact:**

Despite the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, GMBC's commitment to the gospel remained unwavering. Weekly worship service attendance grew, showcasing the community's resilience. The 7th Annual Women's Empowerment Conference was inspirational with distinguished speakers leaving a lasting impact. The A. Carlyle Miller Health Center continued its stellar record of providing comprehensive healthcare, including maternal and child services, to the Long Creek community. A new initiative, the GMBC Tower Builders mentorship program, empowers young adults through a Christ-centered curriculum, reflecting the visionary leadership of Dr. Pinky-Ann Noble-Britton.



### **Challenges and Needs:**

As GMBC looks towards the future, they seek support for several projects. Maximizing land use at Long Creek includes establishing a coconut farm, but securing seedlings poses a challenge due to Guyana's booming coconut industry. Proper upkeep of their sacred spaces necessitates building maintenance for all GMBC churches. Essential equipment like a truck and bobcat would further enhance development at Long Creek. Expanding Camp Somerville and building a nursing home for the elderly are long-term goals. Investing in the future through tertiary scholarship opportunities for aspiring leaders is another priority.

### **Prayer Requests:**

The GMBC community humbly requests prayers for financial independence and wise stewardship to ensure the sustainability of their ministries. Equipping and empowering Christian leaders is crucial for continued growth. They pray for a rising generation of church planters to spread the gospel message. Effective advocacy work across the nation and globally is another prayer focus, along with fostering racial unity and understanding within Guyana. Upholding ethical standards in government is a shared prayer request. Investing in the future through training and empowering more leaders is a priority. Finally, prayers are sought for continued unity and collaboration within Guyana's Ecumenical Community.

### **Nature of the Mission:**

Our mission is rooted in spiritual ministry. Through our congregations, we evangelize communities and plant new churches. We are also active in education, organizing annual biblical training and gift distribution for children during Christmas. We conduct spiritual training for young leaders, pastors, women, and men, and host crusades and spiritual awakenings. With Lott Carey's support, we assist families affected by disasters and contribute to the transformative work of God's church through evangelism, Christian formation, and education.

### **Impact of Ministry:**

The ministry has significantly impacted the Haitian Baptist community, including churches, women, men, young leaders, and especially marginalized and disadvantaged children. Lott Carey's monthly financial support has enabled:

- Employment for eight previously unemployed teachers
- Free education for 400 children
- Improved living conditions for over 60 families

This partnership empowers churches and communities to participate in the transforming work of God in Haiti. Our churches are growing, and we continue to witness spiritual and economic transformation.

### **Number of Persons/Communities Served:**

- Over 4,900 members across 33 congregations
- More than 400 people gave their lives to Christ this year
- 804 children benefited from school support
- 50 teachers received regular salaries

- 10. Construction support for churches damaged by earthquakes
- 11. Two buses for transportation
- 12. Visits from Lott Carey representatives

Mission of Grace is a Christ-centered organization rooted in love and compassion, serving the spiritual, physical, and emotional needs of the Haitian people. It was founded in 2009 following a devastating mudslide in Carries. The ministry is built on five foundational pillars:

1. **Grace Community Medical Clinic** – Healing bodies and souls through essential medical care.

medicine, and prayer.

2. **Grace Community Christian School** – Equipping over 440 students with academic and

spiritual education.

- 3. **Grace Community Christian Church** Proclaiming the Gospel and discipling believers.
- 4. **Children of Grace Orphanage** Providing a safe, loving home for over 220 children and 20 young adults.
- 5. **Home of Grace Elderly Home** Honoring and caring for more than 30 elderly residents.

### **Impact of Ministry:**

In addition to the core programs, Mission of Grace also operates:

- A daily soup kitchen feeding hundreds of people in need
- A sewing program training and empowering women
- Men's and women's ministries offering mentorship, discipleship, and purpose

### **Impact**

In 1947, the Lott Carey Baptist Foreign Mission Convention, USA, partnered with a small prayer group in Delhi, led by the late Rev. John H. Nelson. He would later be appointed Superintendent of the Lott Carey Baptist Mission in India by the Convention. His successors continued this legacy, making significant contributions that fueled the Mission's steady growth. I extend heartfelt thanks to my brothers and sisters in the Lott Carey family for their unwavering financial and prayer support—without which we could not have served and uplifted



countless poor and needy individuals in North India. The Lord walked with us through times of uncertainty, leading us in victory. To Him be all glory and praise, now and forever.

Starting in the late 1940s in Delhi, the Lott Carey Convention began its work in India. Over the course of more than eight decades, this initial support for a humble prayer group has flourished into a thriving organization. By God's grace, the Mission now employs over a thousand individuals and provides education to more than ten thousand students.

Our outreach has expanded to include clinics across six leprosy colonies, seven Non-Formal Education Projects serving children from marginalized communities, and an HIV/AIDS awareness initiative. Around 160 underprivileged children and nursing students have received education through our programs and are now serving as qualified nurses in various hospitals. We also offer financial assistance to hundreds from all walks of life, helping them establish small income-generating businesses and covering hospital expenses for those in need.

The vision and foresight of our founders—Rev. J. H. Nelson, Rev. Dr. Abner Frank Nelson, and Dr. (Mrs.) Ivy Frey Nelson—were instrumental in planting the seeds of this Mission, which have since grown into a wide-reaching and impactful ministry.

We remain deeply grateful to the Lott Carey Convention, USA, for their crucial support throughout this journey. Our core mission continues to be centered on preaching, teaching, and healing.

### **Challenges and Needs**

The mission faces challenges in spreading the Gospel due to increasing difficulties and risks, putting the lives of their evangelists in danger. Additionally, economic challenges persist, we humbly ask for your continued prayers for India—a nation of 1.4 billion people, where 84% survive on less than seven dollars a day. Despite the sincere efforts of our government, the overwhelming scale of poverty continues to present immense challenges, particularly for our marginalized brothers and sisters.

### **Nature of the Mission:**

Trinity Evangelistic Ministries (TEM) is located in Retreat, St. Mary, Jamaica, a rural community facing numerous challenges such as poor infrastructure, limited economic opportunities, and high unemployment. TEM was founded by the late Rev. George Coore with a vision to empower and develop individuals through education and training.

### The ministry operates:

- An early childhood institution for children aged 2–6 years
- A Skills Training Centre in partnership with HEART/NTA (a Government of Jamaica training agency)

### Training areas include:

- General Office Administration
- Commercial Food Preparation
- Hospitality Services (Villa and Property Management)
- Early Childhood Development

- The Basic School has experienced steady growth, with increased enrollment and parental support, prompting considerations for physical expansion.
- The Skills Training Centre faces challenges such as inconsistent attendance due to students' financial responsibilities, but many persist with determination.
- TEM continues to provide critical ministry through personal development, education, and job opportunities.
- The ministry remains committed to sustainability and social justice, aiming to uplift individuals and communities through empowerment and advocacy.

The ministry serves:

- Children in early education
- At-risk youth in vocational training
- Residents of Retreat and surrounding communities

### **Needs for Ministry to Thrive:**

- Continued financial support for educational and training programs

- Resources for sustainability and community outreach

### **Nature of the Mission:**

The Baptist Convention of South Africa (BCSA) implements a multifaceted mission strategy that integrates evangelism, education, empowerment, and community transformation. Central to this mission are church planting and the development of existing congregations to foster spiritual growth and holistic ministry.

Theological education and ministerial formation are facilitated through the Baptist Convention College (BCC), which offers accredited, contextually relevant training for both clergy and laity. Leadership development and capacity building remain strategic priorities, ensuring the formation of ethically grounded and missionally engaged leaders across all levels of the church.



BCSA also addresses pressing social issues through initiatives such as the **Ndawo Yakho Women's Shelter**, which provides a faith-informed response to gender-based violence. The shelter offers accommodation, psychosocial support, and empowerment programs for women and children in crisis.

Additionally, the Convention is engaged in farming and sustainability projects linked to local congregations, promoting food security and economic self-reliance as integral aspects of its mission.

### **Impact of Ministry:**

### Faranani Project

Faranani continues to expand its agricultural and skills development initiatives. The agricultural site is divided into three fields:

- Field A: Planted with green peppers (partially affected by frost), spinach (to be harvested by late July/August), and garlic (harvest due August/September).
- Field B: Scheduled for beetroot planting.
- Field C: Reserved for a joint venture pending learner placement.

The project employs two individuals—one full-time staff member and one learner—with additional support from BCSA staff and stakeholders.

Faranani also launched a **Project Management Learnership** in partnership with Signa Academy. Eight learners are gaining practical experience through BCSA, while Signa provides theoretical instruction. This initiative reflects Faranani's commitment to economic empowerment and community transformation.

### Baptist Convention College (BCC)

Located at the Thusong BCSA Centre, BCC continues to provide theological education and ministerial formation. In the first half of 2025, 35 students were enrolled across three programs:

- Higher Certificate in Theology (via BTC)
- Baptist Studies (BCC's own program)
- Pulse Program (in partnership with Cape Town Baptist Seminary)

Six students received financial aid through EBMI. Despite declining enrollment and infrastructure challenges, BCC is preparing for its **Spring School of Theology** in October, focusing on **Missional Leadership**.

Efforts are underway to secure **SETA accreditation**, with support from Dr. Sipho Moses Zondi, and to expand academic partnerships. However, challenges remain in staff recruitment and infrastructure compliance.

BCC benefits from historic and current partnerships, including former collaborations with the Jamaica Baptist Union and seminaries in the UK and USA. Present partnerships with BTC and Cape Town

Baptist Seminary support accredited qualifications and graduate pathways.

Financial support, primarily from Lott Carey, focuses on student bursaries—especially for women. The college is working to improve policy and reporting mechanisms while striving to stabilize leadership, recruit postgraduate-trained lecturers, and increase administrative capacity.

### Ndawo Yakho Women's Shelter

Located in Yeoville, Johannesburg, Ndawo Yakho provides a safe haven for women and children affected by gender-based violence. From February to June 2025, the shelter supported up to 16 clients, offering:

- Counseling
- Legal aid
- Medical access
- Accommodation
- Spiritual care

Clients participated in skills development activities such as sewing, computer literacy, beading, gardening, and art. The shelter also hosted Bible studies and workshops on conflict management and self-confidence.

Community and church groups visited regularly, offering encouragement and donations. Notable achievements included:

- Obtaining birth certificates and ID documents
- Infrastructure repairs
- Enrolling a child in preschool

Despite limited resources, the shelter remains operational. Key challenges include funding, infrastructure maintenance, and reintegration of clients into society. Recommendations include:

- Constructing a protective brick wall
- Expanding to a nearby property
- Securing transport for client appointments

### **Number of Persons/Communities Served:**

BCSA serves over **30,000 members** across more than **300 churches and fellowships**. With support from Lott Carey, BCSA employs five full-time staff members who provide leadership and operational continuity.

Through BCC, approximately **35 students** are enrolled in accredited theological programs. The **Ndawo Yakho Shelter** supported **11 to 16 women and children** during the reporting period.

BCSA expresses deep gratitude for the continued support of Lott Carey, which enables the success and impact of these ministries.
